### Coastal 36'

Designed after the iconic dug out canoes of the West Coast, this canoe was built at the request of local coastal pacific First Nations and built with input from friend and master canoeist, Stephen Recalma from Qualicum First Nations. The Coastal 36' is built with integral skipper seat and additional Recalma guide seat allowing for multi-position paddling depending on sea state. This is the most stable coastal big canoe on the market so that canoe families can facilitate maximum involvement.



### Montreal 34'

This beautiful canoe is created after the birch bark canoe paddled on the Great Lakes. This 34 foot Big Canoe is equally at home on big rivers, lakes and oceans. Its' massive weight and people carrying capacity make it the perfect choice for school groups, guiding outfits and First Nations groups looking for maximum versatility.



### North Canoe 25'

The North Canoe is designed after the bark north canoes that travelled across Canada for the centennial. This canoe is equally used for its hull speed and its stability for groups. This is one of the few big canoes that can be vehicle-topped and handled by a limited number of participants. All of our North Canoes come standard with our one piece extruded aluminum gunnels giving maximum strength and durability with the lowest weight.
